# THE TIMEWORN SURFACE BY BARBIERI.

This new pattern on unique surface finishing is obtained through new technology that is an evolution of invention by Giovanni Barbieri since 1999.

The procedure first wears out the borders of the tiles then creates semi-opaque natural wavy surface; the procedure which "consumes" the softer parts of the marble composition and also allows the subsequent polishing applied in the same grade of an original historical floor.

The whole procedure is done with ecological abrasive only.

The degree of surface sheen is the same as the original sheen on the floors of the historical buildings in our italian cities.

No matter the amount of usage and traffic that that the marble is subjected to, its sheen and its unique reflections remain unaltered.

For care, maintenance, easy of usage and aesthetical result, we consider this type of surface to be the very best in the antiqued natural stone tile market as it is extremely similar than the original one.

Oil water repellent protection is suggested in reference of the destination use.

Deep scratches can be restored with the electrical tools used by marble workers with final hand made finishing with appropriate glass paper.

This is done by creating additional waves on the surface that can be blend in with the existing grooves thus easily matching the aesthetic characteristics of this surface.

#### SETTING INSTRUCTIONS

All Timeworn mosaics are installed on net using a 2 components glue Kerakoll Superflex ECO (A+B).

Under standard installation conditions the following instructions must be CA-REFULLY observed:

Adhesives

Interior and exterior applications:

Kerakoll Extreme (A+B), Kerakoll Superflex ECO (A+B), MAPEI KERALASTIC T

Use:

The adhesive should be applied both on the piece and installation surface (double-spread technique).

Application should begin from below and the corner profiles applying forward/ reverse motion achieving a uniform setting, any excess adhesive should be removed using a dry spatula or sponge.

#### PRECAUTIONS

Timeworn Mosaics products are intended to be used for coverings and floor applications.

Use of non-specific adhesives may cause improper installation.

Application temperature should range between  $5^{\circ}$ C and  $25^{\circ}$ C (41 and 77 F), above  $25^{\circ}$ C (77 F) the setting layer should be dampened with enough water and pieces installed on the moist surface.

Do not install on irregular or painted surfaces.

Do not install on degraded\humid plaster coverings.

Do not install on light mortar or lime, any dust should be removed.

Installation surfaces subject to high temperatures must be properly isolated. Expansion joints must be applied every 10 sq.m. (108 SF) for exterior installations, 25 sq.m.(270 SF) for interior installations and every 8 metres (26') in length for long and narrow surfaces. Structural, split and perimeter joints must be observed.

Use of specific adhesives and setting methods indicated on our official documents refers to normal interior/exterior surface application not subject to particular conditions out of the standard building code procedures.

Non-standard applications must be discussed before installation in order to receive the most suitable setting solution.


















#### BIOGRAPHY

Giovanni started his career at the age of 14, working in the marble sector as a go-getter.

By the time he was 16, he was capable of completing floorings by himself for his older brother's business.

In 1984, at the age of 18, Giovanni contributed 50% of the investment and entered into a business partnership with his brother by establishing F.LLI Barbieri.

By then, the company had already started producing tumbled marbles for its own projects.

At the age of 22, Giovanni started attending school courses in interior design from 1989 to 1997.

His best results were achieved on building site projects - projects where he worked together with the architects who taught the classes.

These collaborations reinforced a period of strong progression: Giovanni was the only project developer and supplier of marble tiles that came exclusively from the Family Stone company and personally supervised the installations.

The emphasis was placed on the production process and the design of new products; first for the local market,

then all the way to the United States, thanks to the excellent understanding of design, research and

development and the excellent longstanding collaboration with Nancy Epstein.

Many patents were developed in the late 90's such as "MARMO ANTICO LUCIDO"; "FRAMENTI BORDER"; "TIMEWORN MARBLE" and more were to follow.

Giovanni participated in various Contemporary Art Competitions receiving a special mention in Torino in 2003 with Roberto Lanaro, a renowned European Metal Artist-Sculptor.

In 2008, "AMBRA COLLECTION" received an American Architecture award and was featured at "Triennale Design Museum" in Milan for more than a year.

In 2010, Giovanni started his successful collaboration with Sara Baldwin developing irreproducible

Timeworn Mosaics a best seller after 10 years, as well as Ambra.

Giovanni Barbieri has been a source of inspiration for many renowned brands resulting in the successful reproduction of his Inventions and Techniques; AMBRA is an example reproduced by many.

In 2013, the first Engineered 3D Marble Tiles Collections Exciton/ Hive was awarded at Best-Of-Year INTERIOR DESIGN. This Collection is produced by recycling marble dust from production waste for high performance installation where natural stone is not preferred.

In 2013, the Memento Porcelain Tile Collection was Best-of-Year INTERIOR DESIGN Award-winner with Vallelunga Ceramica.

In 2014, Giovanni was the Winner of the London Surface Design Award with "CLAS" on Belgian project.

2015 is the year of the Murano Collection; Award Winner at Best-Of-Year INTERIOR DESIGN, NYC.

In 2016, the world's first true 3D porcelain tile collection "TRILOGY", winner of Boy INTERIOR DESIGN, was presented in the USA and at New York City Design Award in May 2017 at the MoMa in NYC.

2017 marks the launch of new shading flat 3D wall tiles: "Collection RR".

In 2018, a new chapter begins with new Antiqued handmade Black terracotta tiles in an "easy-care" version: the "Minimal Rustic Collection".

2018-19-20 was the initial success of the first version of SQUAR[E] Collection, between the tile collection and Art performance, it won triple awards in the USA also at the BoY Awards, and by ARCHITECTURAL RECORD USA Magazine also with the handmade ceramic tile collection "KLE".

2020 is over and the Terrazzo Collection "The Fine Lines" was nominated Overall Winner at SBID (The Society of British International Interior Design) product design Awards in London.

INTERIOR DESIGN USA: Best of Year Awards nominated Giovanni one of the four best Product Designers.

The Fine Lines Terrazzo Collection won a Boutique Design New York International Design Competition in the Floor Covering Category.

On 2021 March, Squar[e] ceramic tile size 2" x 2" 3/4 received the Red Dot Product design 2021 Award.
